

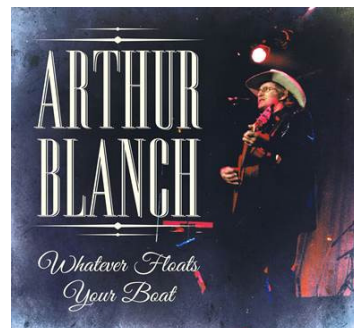

My Son Steve's Winter Soup

2 Cloves Garlic finely chopped
1 Medium Onion finely chopped
1 Tsp fresh Ginger finely chopped
1 ½ tsp Curry Powder
2 Cups Diced Pumpkin
1 Cup diced sweet Potatoe
1 can Coconut Milk to taste
1 Cup Red Lentils (Soft)
2 Cups Vegetable Stock



Sauté garlic, onion, and ginger lightly in a dash of oil.
Add curry powder and stir through.
Stir in pumpkin and sweet potato.
Add stock, blend add lentils.
Bring to the boil, turn down and simmer.
Add coconut milk to taste.
Cook 15 mins.
Serve with a squeeze of lime and crusty bread.

Allan Caswell has been successfully writing songs for over 40 years with over 900 songs published and 500 recordings of them world-wide. He is a winner of 6 Golden Guitars, 11 TSA awards and several gold and platinum albums and 2 Gold Singles for his songwriting and production work.
