Ella Radbone

Ella Radbone is our 2013 South Australian 13 years and Under Champion of Champions.



Ella began her involvement in the music industry learning to play guitar with **Tammy Wellman** at Tamwel Arts in February 2011. By the end of that year, Ella had began her enjoyable journey performing country music. From that point forward, Ella was hooked on performing and building her skills on guitar and vocals.

2012 saw Ella achieve many 'firsts', including school assembly performances, radio appearances, walk ups, street busking, and her very first talent quest at the **Barmera Country Music Festival**.

At 9 years of age, Ella was awarded 3rd place at the **Gawler Country Music Club** talent quest for Junior Vocal 13 years and under, and 2nd place at the **Port Pirie Music Festival** for Junior Gospel 15 years and under. Ella also performed at the **Adelaide Country Music Club** for the first time and confidently played a 45 minute set at another venue.

By mid 2012 it became obvious that Ella was 100% set on performing **Country Music** when she saved for and purchased her very own Mini Maton acoustic guitar, playing it for the first time in public at the very first Tamwel Arts Showcase.

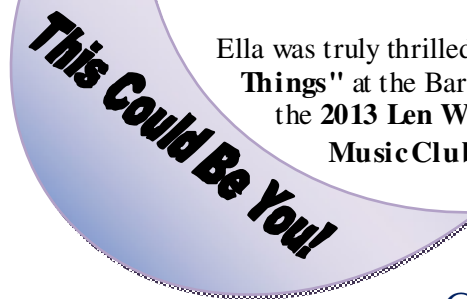
Highlights for Ella include performing with the **McLaren Vale Community Carols Choir**, qualifying for CMSA's **Champion of Champions** and being involved in the **Davidson Brothers Instrumental Workshop**. Ella also has an interest in banjo, which her late grandfather played.

2013 was a very busy year for Ella, performing at numerous community events, including the **McLaren Vale Sea and Vines Festival** and Tamwel Arts Fundraisers.

Ella had the pleasure to perform with the major school theatre production of "**Joseph and the Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat**", and also appearing as guest artist at the **McLaren Vale Community Carols** with her own original Christmas Song.

Ella qualified in the top three for a number of different talent quests throughout 2013 in Swan Reach, Laura, Gawler, and Barmera.

Ella was truly thrilled to receive 1st in the Open Songwriting Award with her first penned song "**Good Things**" at the Barmera Country Music Festival and Awards. It was here that Ella was also awarded the **2013 Len Wakefield Memorial Award** by **Lorraine Wakefield** of the **Adelaide Country Music Club**.
