**Lyn:** It's good to be here.

**SR:** Sit back and relax. We have some chocolates, we've got some Minties, and we've got some M & Ms. What's your preference?

**Lyn:** (Laughs...) I've gotta go for the M & Ms today... bit of a crunch.

**SR:** You're from Toowoomba in Queensland, just like myself. There seems to be a great deal of talent from little Ol' Toowoomba these days. Most people know **Gina Jeffreys** of course. I'm wondering if that's because the day care centre is above the local radio station, and we were all brought up by **Dolly Parton** and **Merle Haggard**. What do you think?

**Lyn:** Maybe. I never went to day-care, so I don't know if your theory is gonna stick. (Laughs...)

**SR:** You're currently living in the Hunter Valley. What do you miss most about Toowoomba?

**Lyn:** My family. Hands down.

**SR:** I can agree with you there.

**SR:** You've just come back from playing at the **Gympie Muster**. That seems to be getting bigger every year. How was it for you?

**Lyn:** It was unreal actually. I think the best part for me was I did two of my own shows at **The Grove**. It's such a really cool venue. I also really loved getting out there and playing with other people. I did a songwriters gig, and also played with **Peter Denahy and Friends**. It was myself, **Brendan Radford**, **Lloyd Spiegel**, and **Pete**. Playing alongside Lloyd is amazing. He's a blues player and singer, and he's just fantastic. And Brendan is an amazing player and singer. Pete's just so much fun and so gifted. It was really fun.

**SR:** That sounds great. If you could hand pick your musos, who would be in your 'dream band'?

**Lyn:** I'm very lucky I get to actually work with one of my dream musos - **Bill Risby** on keys. He's an absolute master, so, I'd definitely have Bill on keys. **Jeff McCormack** on bass. I would have the band that played on my record actually. **Shane Nicholson** playing guitars. Definitely **Jim Moline** playing guitars as well. He does this really cool stuff. Just an unreal player. And **Josh Schuberth** on drums.

**SR:** From your last album **'Secret Songs'** - I like the clever use of the bass guitar in **'Beautiful Liar'**, but **'Sing along'** is just so catchy. And what an awesome film clip from **Duncan (Toombs)** and the crew. I bet you that was fun to make.

**Lyn:** It was actually. We filmed that in a couple of the main streets in **Newcastle** and also down an alley way. It was lots of fun and we actually stopped traffic at one stage. We just traipsed around the city with lots of friends and family involved, so it was good.

**SR:** You've also recently released a new album **'Heart Of Sorrow'**. How's that going?

**Lyn:** Very well, actually. It's out through **Maven/Sony**. I've got a really good place to be at because I've got the love and attention of a little label, but the backing of a big one. The album itself I'm really proud of. I've never felt so assured musically in a record before. We've had some excellent reviews. It's being picked up by radio and **CMC (Country Music Channel)**. **Shane (Nicholson)** who produced it has been getting loads of really great feedback. So, all round it's doing really well.
