Ma's Country Kitchen

Beef Cordon Blue

- 8 minute steak (beef)
- 4 slices lean leg ham (deli) thick
- 4 slices Swiss cheese
- 1 cup plain flour
- 2 cups dried breadcrumbs
- 2 egg beaten lightly
- 3 tbs milk
- 50 gms butter
- 4 tbs vegetable oil



Trim ham and cheese slices to smaller than the minute steaks.

Place a piece of cheese on the steak, add a piece of ham, then top with 2nd minute steak.

Secure edges with a tooth pick.

When all steaks are prepared, combine egg and milk and mix well.

Place egg mix, flour and breadcrumbs into separate shallow dishes.

Lightly flour meat parcels, dip into egg mix then roll in breadcrumbs.

Heat oil and butter in fry-pan over medium heat.

Add crumbled steak parcels, cook gently on both sides until golden brown, approximately 5 minutes on each side.

Drain on a papertowel and remove tooth picks before serving.

Serve with a lemon wedge, boiled vegetables, or a salad.

After a highly successful transition to the Summer Tamworth Country Music Festival in 2014 the Academy is again running its progressive programme in the lead up to the popular Tamworth Festival.

The Academy is made up of four distinct courses.

1. Singer/songwriter/performer Course for Junior and Senior artists. The 21 Senior Students attend a two week course in Tamworth set in the Calrossy School. All meals and accommodation are provided and the students have a unique opportunity to bond with each other and to perfect their skills.

The staff at the Academy are drawn from the very best singer/songwriter/performers in the Industry. For 2015 **Kevin Bennett, Tamara Stewart and Lyn Bowtell** are Senior group leaders and Songwriting guru **Karl Broadie** is the Songwriter in residence conducting all the songwriting tuition modules. Songwriting, performance, vocals, harmony singing, instrumental work, chart writing and video and record production. Then there's all the Industry career building modules as well. Digital marketing, managing your career, working with the media, social media and web, publishing, self management, working with venues and much more. The 21 Juniors stay for only a week but it's just as intense. Their group tutors are **David and Merelyn Carter** and **Amber Lawrence**. They also receive tuition in vocals, guitar, performance, songwriting and many other skills.

2. Instrumental Course. The Instrumental course is made up of musicians who are mainly interested in playing instruments and creating careers as working musicians. Every star requires a killer band behind them and this career opportunity is catered for at The Academy. Students get an intense two week training course under the tutelage of **Brad Bergen**. They learn chart writing, playing and maintenance of instruments, performing behind artists, recording techniques for session musicians and get plenty of mentoring and tutoring on their Instruments.

3. Parent Course. In addition to these great courses there is a Parent's course run by **Jim Haynes** which seeks to help parents through the difficult process of managing a talented child through the early years and helping them achieve their goals. The Course allows Parents to bond with others and discuss ideas and opportunities. The Academy is a unique enterprise by the CMAA involving over 85 people creating a groundswell of great country music talent in Australia and New Zealand.
