Golden Fruit & Fibre Cookies

1 ½ cup Self Raisin Flour sifted
1 ½ Right Start Fruit & Fibre cereal
½ cup Brown Sugar
1 tsp Cinnamon
80g Butter
¼ cup Golden Syrup
½ tsp Bicarbonate of soda
1 large Egg lightly beaten



Preheat oven to 160c – 140c fan force
Melt butter with golden syrup; add 1 tbs water and bicarbonate of soda.
Pour butter mixture onto dry ingredients with the egg and stir to combine.
Roll tablespoons of mixture into balls and place onto lined tray. Flatten slightly.
Bake for 13 – 15 mins.
Cool completely and store in an airtight container for 2 days.
You can add extra dry fruit or nuts if you like.

Did you know?

In 1957, "A Pub With No Beer" by Slim Dusty became the first Australian single to go gold. It was the first single by an Australian artist to make the British charts. And has remained in the Top 100 Australian songs since its release.

John Lennon sung The Beatles classic 'Yellow Submarine' by immersing a microphone in a bottle of water. A condom was used over the microphone to protect him from electric shock.

Australian Country Music legend Stan Coster worked as a ringer, fencer, slaughterman, horse-breaker, kangaroo shooter, and shed hand and was able to draw these experiences into his bush ballads. Popular compositions such as his "Three Rivers Hotel", which tells the story of building a train line into a remote nickel mine, were based on his own life experiences.

The last song Elvis performed in private was a rendition of "Blue Eyes Crying In the Rain," done on his piano in Graceland hours before his death.

The FLANGER effect used to create the swooshing sound used by many recording artists like the Ventures, and Les Paul was originally created by an engineer slowing down a reel to reel recorder by lightly pressing a finger on the flange of one of the ployout reels.

Before Glen Campbell became a country-pop legend, he was one of the busiest session guitarists. His playing can be heard on songs from The Beach Boys to Frank Sinatra.
