Jamie Slape

Instrumentalist/Singer

Jamie Slape started playing music at five years old and was taught the ropes of performing from his late Poppy.

Now 13 years old, Jamie's fondest memories are playing *Stand By Me* and original song *Just Us Sound* busking with his Poppy in the main street of the Barmera Country Music Festival.

"My Poppy started teaching me guitar and was a big influence on me playing and continuing country music"

At ten years old Jamie competed in his first talent quest and busked with his Poppy's band **"Just Us"**.

A regular at the Barmera festival, Jamie has achieved numerous awards in the past three years. Previous to 2014, Jamie predominantly played electric lead guitar busking and entering instrumental sections. This year Jamie achieved his goal to play and sing at the same time and entered both instrumental and vocal sections, taking home **four awards**.

At Barmera Country Music Festival 2014, Jamie won *Encouragement – 16 years & Under, 2nd Open Instrumental* (against adults) and *1st Junior Indigenous*.

Jamie has qualified for the 2014 South Australian Champion of Champions and has upcoming guest spots at both the **Gawler Country Music Club** and **Adelaide Country Music Club**.

Jamie was honoured to receive the **2014 Len Wakefield Memorial Award**, which is provided to assist young artists in developing their music careers.

Mentored by **Tammy Wellman (Tamwel Arts)** and sponsored by the **Gawler Country Music Club**, **Jamie Slape** has built a new relationship with his local club participating at the **Gawler Country Music Club Music Workshops** to further build his musicianship and increase his confidence, performing and public speaking skills.

Jamie's goals for 2014 include his enthusiasm to immerse himself in the country music industry and not sit on the sidelines.



He is making a real effort to build new friendships, meet new people and learn new songs. All this, whilst also building up his guitar skills, and gaining lots of great experience, thanks to his supportive audiences.
