Slim Dusty fans and beer drinkers unite as **The Pub With No Beer** takes on a new purpose.

Yup! A continuous supply of beer is now guaranteed at **'The Pub With No Beer'**.

Prominent signs on the highway around the **Mid North NSW** town of **Macksville** point to **The Pub With No Beer**. If you take a trip to **Taylor's Arm** (a village of about 70 residents) you can sample beers that, legend has it, previous visitors missed out on.

Brewery owner **Murray Howe** assures visitors that **The Pub will never run dry again**, and what's more, the taps will be filled with world-class ales. 'Patrons can now enjoy the ultimate craft beer experience.'

'Our objective is to integrate 100% Australian owned, full flavoured, full aroma craft beers with food; entertainment; education and brewery interaction. **It's a beer-lover's nirvana.**'

The restaurant's facilities have been completely refurbished and the food service upgraded to be among the best pub food locations on the North Coast.

For the first time, **The Pub With No Beer Brewery** will host private events and tour groups, providing **tailored group packages** including beer appreciation classes; lunches and dinners etc.

The Pub With No Beer is a true Australian icon.

For 100 years The Pub With No Beer has dispensed **'Australia's most valuable liquid asset'**.

Local timber cutter and songwriter, **Gordon Parsons**, immortalized the story in what became one of Australia's most famous songs, **The Pub With No Beer**.

The song was recorded by **Slim Dusty** and became the biggest selling single in 1958. It remains one of Australia's top 50 biggest selling singles.
