He released his first album, **"Sunset Country"** in 1997, the rest, as they say, is history. Music took him interstate to festivals, clubs, parties and private gigs.

In 1999, his CD **"Mallee Country"** was released and **Chooka became a favourite regular at Mildura CM Festival, Barmera, Swan Hill, Tamworth** and many others.

Such was his popularity at this time that he resigned his employment and joined the few musicians working full time successfully in **Country Music.**

Two years later, his next CD, **"Fern Haven"** was produced.

As a milestone in **Australian Country Music**, his award winning song **"Old Akubra Hat"** was ceremoniously placed in the time capsule at **Balcoldon, Queensland.**
