## Ma's Country Kitchen

**Carlene** is in the kitchen today with a yummy **Frittata** and also a **Sultana Cake**.

### Pumpkin and Onion Frittata

1 large Onion chopped  
350g grated Pumpkin (not butternut)  
130g Arborio Rice  
Nutmeg  
3 large Eggs  
1 cup grated Parmesan  
1/3 to 1/2 cup Cream  
100g Ricotta Cheese  
Salt  
Toasted Breadcrumbs



Fry onion until soft, add pumpkin (add a little more oil if to dry), cook with lid on over a low heat. Boil rice for 8 mins and strain. Beat eggs; add ricotta, cream, parmesan, nutmeg and salt. Mix into pumpkin mixture, and then add rice. Brush base and sides of a spring form pan with melted butter, sprinkle lightly with toasted breadcrumbs. Pour pumpkin mixture into pan and level. Sprinkle lightly with more breadcrumbs. Cook at 180c for 35-40 mins. Serve with salad and chutney.

### Boiled Sultana Cake

250g Butter  
3 eggs  
1 destspn Cornflour  
1 tsp Baking Powder  
350g Sultanas  
250g Sugar  
300g Plain Flour  
1/2 cup Water  
Pinch Salt  
3/4 cup Water

Pre heat oven at 150c. Grease a 20cm cake tin and line with paper. Place 3/4 cup water and sultanas into a saucepan and boil until water is all absorbed. Put aside to cool. When cool, sprinkle with a little flour. Cream butter and sugar; add cornflour mixed in 1/2 cup water, then eggs, flour and sultanas. Bake for approx 1 1/2 hours.
