## Telstra Awards to James Blundell

James Blundell was the big winner at the **9th Australian Independent Country Music Awards** – the Telstra Country Wide Southern Stars.

James won APRA/AMCOS Independent **Country Music Single of the Year** and **Male Vocalist** with Postcards from Saigon, and **Heritage of the Year** with Nature's Gentleman.

It is a triumphant move into the Independent recording ranks for the former major label artist who has won 9 Golden Guitars.

**Tracy Coster** continued her winning way when **Coster Country** won the coveted **One Stop Entertainment Independent Album of the Year**. The album has already attracted awards for 2004 Independent Heritage Track of the Year and a Golden Guitar (with **Anne Kirkpatrick**) for Vocal Collaboration.

Sydney vocalist **Stacey Morris** won the **Female Vocalist** category with Moonlight & Roses, Shelley Evans took the Rising Star Female category with Aces From The Man, and **Royden Donohoe** won Rising Star Male with We're Gone.
