Oak Valley Aboriginal School principal Vivien Deed said **Jeanette's** visit was a great success with positive learning outcomes for the students.

"It gives them a chance to be creative and make up their own songs. It was good to see that all the kids got involved with the inma and good to see the family members turn up."

"Events like Jeanette's visit give the kids an experience we can't offer them. The children have music in them. It's something that they love and they love to participate in...."

Jeanette has been working on music programmes with SA Aboriginal communities for more than ten years.

Having worked with many Aboriginal communities "I think the **Yalata children's songs** could be a hit – especially "**Roly Poly Wombat**" and "**Bush Sweet.**" It's really important for children to hear and sing songs that relate to their own lives."

Jeanette Wormald is a professional singer songwriter based in Adelaide.

She has released four albums and has enjoyed national and international success with her music, performing at major music festivals including the **Adelaide Fringe Festival** and the **Adelaide Cabaret festival, Tamworth and the Gympie Muster.**
