## Ma's Country Kitchen

Rhonda is here today to create her yummy cheesecake for us.

### Rhonda's cake is **Berry Cheesecake**

#### Ingredients:

200g Plain Sweet Biscuits  
(I use Nice Biscuits)  
160g Melted Margarine  
3 Tsp Melted Gelatine  
¼ cup Water  
250g Philadelphia Cream Cheese (Softened)  
¾ cup Caster Sugar  
Grated rind of one Orange  
300 mls Thickened Cream (whipped)  
250g Frozen Mixed Berries (thawed)

#### Method:

Grease a 20cm (8") spring-form tin.  
Process biscuits in a food processor until mixture resembles fine breadcrumbs.  
Transfer to a bowl, and add melted margarine. Stir until well combined.  
Press mixture evenly over base of tin.  
Refrigerate until firm.  
Sprinkle gelatine over water in a heatproof jug. Stand jug in a small saucepan of simmering water, stirring until gelatine has dissolved.  
Remove from heat and cool for 5 mins.  
Beat cream cheese, sugar and orange rind with an electric beater until smooth.  
Stir gelatine mixture into cream cheese mixture then fold in the cream.  
Add half the berries to the mixture and gently fold through.  
Spoon into prepared biscuit shell.  
Cover with plastic wrap and refrigerate for two and a half hours or until set.  
To serve, top cheesecake with a little whipped cream and remaining berries and dust with icing sugar.
