Christmas Crackers

Merry Berry Tarts

Makes 12
 300 mls Thickened Cream
 1 cup thick Custard
 12 tart Pastry Shells (homemade or shop bought)
 1 punnet Strawberries, hulled & chopped
 1 punnet Blueberries
 1 punnet Raspberries

Beat cream until soft peaks form, and then stir in custard.
 Spoon filling into tart shells.
 Top with berries and dust with icing sugar to serve.

Rice Bubble Snow Balls

85g Copha chopped
 100g Vanilla Marshmallows chopped
 2 cups Rice Bubbles
 ¾ cup Coconut Milk Powder
 ¼ cup Icing Sugar

Mix the copha and the marshmallows in a heat proof bowl.
 Put this bowl carefully into a saucepan of simmering water.
 Melt the mixture over low heat, until both ingredients have melted.
 (this mixture will not mix together)
 In a large bowl mix the Rice Bubbles, coconut milk powder, icing sugar and melted copha mixture, combine well.
 Roll level tablespoon of mixture into balls on a foil lined tray.
 Set and store in the fridge.
 Serve sprinkled with icing sugar.
 Serves 30
