### A Seasonal Recipe Tiramisu Ice-Cream

2tbls Instant Coffee  
 2tbls Tia Maria  
 600mls Cream  
 12 sponge Finger Biscuits  
 1/3 cup Boiling water  
 400g Nestles Condensed Milk  
 1/4 cup Milk  
 Combine coffee, water and Tia Maria put to one side.

Combine Nestles Milk and Cream with electric mixer until thick.  
 Beat in 1/2 coffee mixture.  
 Combine remaining coffee mixture with milk and brush wee over both sides of sponge biscuits.  
 Line a 20cm square cake pan with foil, spoon 1/2 cream into pan and top with biscuits, top with remaining cream and freeze until set. You can make this days before you need to use it.
