Ma's Country Kitchen

Today we have two lovely ladies in the kitchen.
Carleen is making

Apricot and Weetbix Balls

250g Dried Apricots
1 cup Orange, Apple or Mango Juice
½ cup Desiccated Coconut
8 Weetbix
¼ cup Honey
Place Apricots and juice into a saucepan, simmer over low heat for 10 mins until apricots have softened and juice thickened. Set aside to cool.
Place biscuits into food processor and process until finely crushed. Add apricot and honey mixture to combine. Form mixture into small balls squeezing mixture together. Roll in coconut. Store in fridge.

Date and Almond Balls

3 cups coarsely chopped dates
3 tsp finely grated orange rind ¼ tsp ground cardamom
1 tbs Honey
2/3 cup blanched almonds toasted
¼ cup coconut

Apple & Chocolate Chip Cake

1 ½ cups Self-Raisin Flour
3 Eggs
8 Dates
1 tsp vanilla
½ cup Sugar (Optional)
½ cup Choc Chips
4 tbs Butter or Marg
1/3 cup Mixed Fruit
1/3 cup Currants
4 Granny Smith Apples
chopped
½ cup Milk



Place chopped apples in a bowl with all fruit, chopped dates, add vanilla, melted butter and beaten eggs. Fold in flour, lastly add milk and mix till all ingredients are blended. Line base of baking tin, bake in moderate oven ¾ hour or when skewer is inserted comes out dry. Cool on wire rack. I did not use sugar as cake was sweet enough using fruit and apples only.
Place all ingredients except coconut into a large bowl, mix to combine.
Using a food processor, process mixture in batches until a paste forms. Lightly wet hands and roll mixture into small balls then roll in coconut.
