RENEWALS DUE ON APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup>

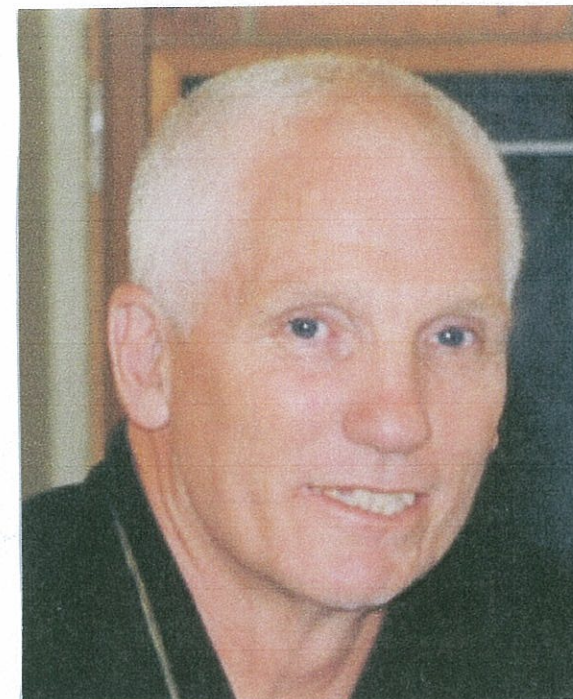
