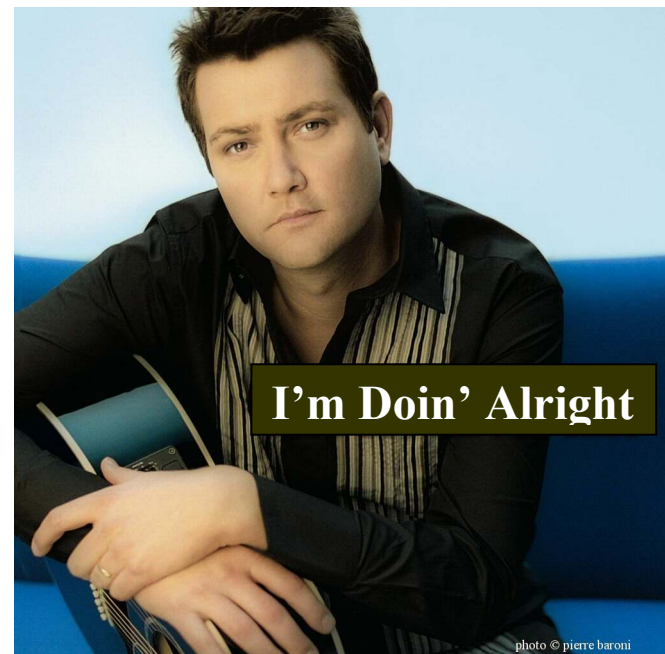


Tamworth Finalists

Chocolate Truffles

Warning!

Do not attempt this recipe if you are lacking in self discipline; if you have difficulty with eating only **one** chocolate from a box of chocolates, or if you experience an uncontrollable urge to overindulge in pure ecstasy....

Makes

About 20

Ingredients

- 225g good-quality dark chocolate, broken into small pieces
- 175ml double cream
- Icing sugar, to dust
- Cocoa powder, sifted, to roll

Method

Place chocolate in a large mixing bowl. Place cream in a saucepan and bring to the boil, then immediately pour over chocolate. Mix until chocolate has melted.

Set aside at room temperature, covered, for 1-1 1/2 hours to cool completely and until set. Use a teaspoon to spoon out bite-sized pieces. Dust your hands with a little icing sugar to prevent them sticking and roll mixture into balls in the palm of your hands. Roll in cocoa; serve with coffee.

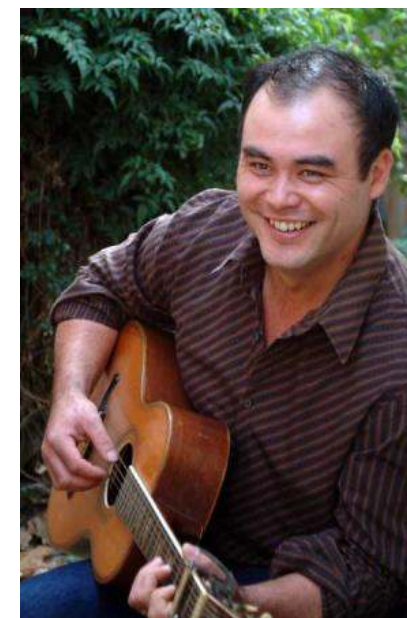
