Ma's Country Kitchen

**Crispy
Rosemary and
Garlic Potatoes**
Serves 4

1kg Sebago Potatoes

¼ Cup Olive Oil

1 Garlic Clove Crushed

1 tablespoon Chopped Rosemary

Peel the potatoes and cut into 3cm cubes. Place in saucepan, cover with cold water. Bring to the boil, reduce heat and simmer for 10 minutes or until tender. Drain well.

Heat oil in large frying pan over medium heat, add potatoes.

Cook potatoes for 10 to 12 minutes tossing occasionally or until golden. Just before potatoes are ready add Garlic and Rosemary tossing the potatoes gently. Remove from frying pan, drain for a few minutes on paper towel. Season with Salt and Pepper.

You could replace rosemary with sage, chives or Parsley.

English Muffin Pizzas

Makes 4

2 English Muffins

1 ½ tablespoons tomato Paste

75g shaved ham or salami chopped

1 Tomato finely chopped

1 cup grated cheese

4 Eggs

Preheat oven to 200c, line baking tray with baking paper. Carefully cut each muffin in half. Place muffins cut side up on tray, spread with tomato paste. Combine Ham, Tomato and Cheese in a bowl, spoon mixture onto muffins. Use your finger to clear a space the size of a 50c coin in the middle of each muffin.

Crack an egg into the middle and bake for 20 to 25 minutes. Serve immediately
