Let's not forget our Doggies

The following recipes are for your canine pets. No responsibility accepted for human consumption. For special occasions, but remember too many treats can lead to weight problems.

Doggy's Peanut Butter Biscuits

- 1 1/2 cup oat flour
- 1/2 cup soy flour
- 1 Tbl. Baking powder
- 1 1/4 cup peanut butter
- 3/4 cup milk

Preheat oven to 200 degrees.

In a mixing bowl, combine oat flour, soy flour and baking powder.

In a blender, blend peanut butter and milk.

Pour peanut butter mixture into dry ingredients and mix well.

Turn dough out onto a lightly floured surface and knead lightly.

Roll out dough 1 cm thick and cut into squares or use a cookie cutter.

Place biscuits on baking tray about 2 cms apart

Bake for 15 min., or until lightly browned.

Biscuits should be refrigerated or frozen.

Doggy's Bacon Biscuits

- 5 cups - Whole wheat flour

- 1 cup - Milk

- 2 - Eggs

- 1 tbs - bacon fat or vegetable oil

- 1 pinch - garlic powder

- 1 ts - Salt

- 1/2 cup - Cold water

- 1 tb - bacon fat or vegetable oil (to grease tray)

Mix all ingredients well. Pinch off pieces of the dough and roll them into 2 cm balls.

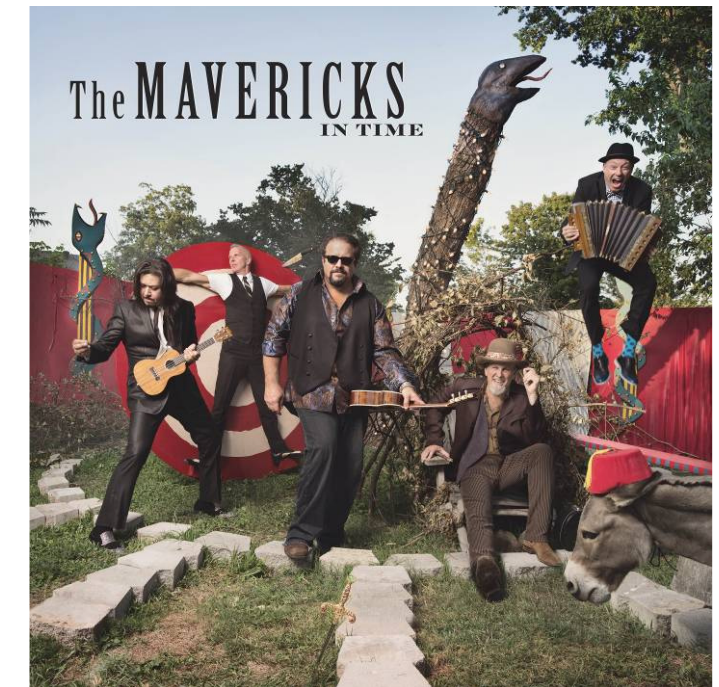
Put them on a greased tray.

Bake them at 175 degrees for 35 to 40 minutes.

Let them cool, then store in an airtight container.
