If you happen to bump into **Slim Connor** on your travels, do have a chat with him. You are sure to be impressed with his friendly nature. Multi award winning song writer and popular singer **Slim Connor** is one of the most pleasant characters around.

Born **Francis Michael Connor** he's been called **Slim** from an early age by everyone who knew him because of his love of **Slim Dusty's** songs.

He grew up in a musical family on a farm in the small town of **Lake Boga** just out of **Swan Hill** where he remembers having many musical nights with friends and neighbours.

Over the years as a growing child his mum would sing and his dad played the accordion, his brothers and sisters all sang too. There was always music in their house.

His love of country music came through listening to the 'Hill Billy Hour' on Radio 3SH.

When milking the cows he would get the cows in early so he wouldn't miss out on any of the program.

He loved the lyrics and stories of people and places in the country. **Country Music** was his life and **Slim Dusty** his idol.

Slim can remember his dad making him an old guitar from a tin can, tie wire and a piece of timber. It was pretty rough but he used to bash on it and sing along.

He also had a small toy guitar and dreamt of one day being on stage singing **Slim Dusty** song**s** and yodelling.

He still has that guitar to this day. It hangs in his music room along with the many other trophies he's received over the years.

Slim mostly taught himself to play guitar. He also learned from friends of the family such as **Bluey Francis** and **Ernie Heath...** picking up ideas from **Country Music shows** whenever he could. He still remembers the day when he walked 5 miles to see **Buddy Williams** performing.

When **Slim** was 16, he appeared in several **Slim Dusty** shows. He also performed with **Buddy Williams** many times over the years, and with **Chad Morgan**, **Dusty Rankin** and **Kevin Shegog**.
