Dusty's widow **Joy McKean**, who recently celebrated her 80th birthday with a concert on January 21 at Tamworth, agreed. "As yet, no one has crystallised what it means to be 'country' like **Slim** did. He was the point of reference for **country music**, and I don't think we have that now. A lot of people are paying lip-service to **country music** for their own means, without having a genuine feeling for the music."

But no matter how good the country artist, there is still the matter of getting heard.....

In the US - where **Keith Urban** is a huge star - there is a vast network of country radio stations... something Australia lacks... **Felicity Urquhart**, who won **Female Artist of the Year** at Tamworth January 2010, and she sat in as host of **ABC Radio's Saturday Night Country** program while regular host **John Nutting** was on leave, says... that in the absence of other outlets, "all we can do is try our best to promote, expand and educate the listeners ... I truly believe there's something in **Country Music** for every **Australian**."

Adam Harvey gives his views..."The 'old guard' tend to forget that the traditional Tamworth crowd is getting older," he says. "I understand we've got to respect our heritage, but we've also got to make sure we're encouraging a steady influx of **young performers**. And if we've got to drag a few people with us to move the industry forward, we'll do what we have to."
