Tiramisu Ice-cream

- 2tbls Instant Coffee
- 2tbls Tia Maria
- 600mls Cream
- 12 sponge Finger Biscuits
- 1/3 cup Boiling water
- 400g Nestles Condensed Milk
- 1/4 cup Milk

Combine coffee, water and Tia Maria put to one side.
Combine Nestles Milk and Cream with electric mixer until thick. Beat in 1/2 coffee mixture.

Combine remaining coffee mixture with milk and brush wee over both sides of sponge biscuits.
Line a 20cm square cake pan with foil, spoon 1/2 cream into pan and top with biscuits, top with remaining cream and freeze until set. You can make this days before you need to use it.
