Carlene's Currie Pasta Salad

1 1/2 cups small raw shell pasta
1 small red capsicum (finely chopped)
2 Tablespoons chopped parsley
1/2 cup spring onions (chopped)
2 sticks celery (chopped finely)
2 tablespoons sultanas

Cook pasta in boiling water until just tender, cool under cold water then drain.

Place remaining ingredients in a sealable bowl, add pasta then stir in dressing.

Dressing

1/2 cup salad oil (I use only 1/3 cup),
1/4 cup apple cider vinegar,
2 teaspoons curry powder
1 tablespoon sugar.
Beat well, and then stir through salad.

Carlene's Broccoli Salad

2 or three heads broccoli
1/2 cup celery chopped
1/2 cup salted cashew nuts
1/2 cup spring onions sliced

250gr cooked bacon chopped
1/2 cup sunflower seeds
1/4 cup almonds chopped
1/2 cup sultanas

Break broccoli into very small pieces, using only the tops.
Just before serving, add remaining ingredients and toss with dressing.

Dressing:

1 cup mayonnaise
1/3 cup sugar and 2-4 tablespoons vinegar.
Beat well together.

Kindred Spirit's final appearance at a **Country Music Club** will be at **Gawler Country Music Club Sunday 17 March.**

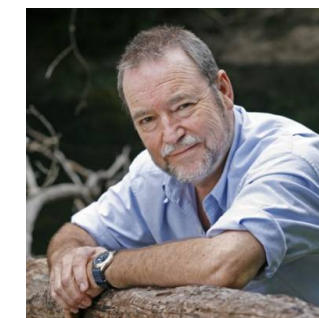
We hope to see you all there for our Final Farewell.

Oz Talent Attracted by US Dollars

John Williamson has been the voice of country music for four decades and he believes the sound of Australia is drowning under the flood of American music.

Recently in Adelaide promoting his South Australian tour, Williamson said Australian artists are unable to match the might of the American dollar. "We're always fighting against American money," he said.

"We're competing against (video) clips that are made for hundreds of thousands of dollars and look like movies. Artists are turning their backs on their home country to record and play overseas.

"It bothers me when people like some of our country artists record overseas." "I can't believe that they don't think to use our studios and our musicians.
