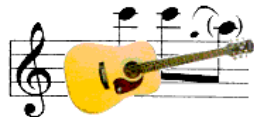

# Here To Stay

In January 2012 **The Davidson Brothers** won the FENDER INSTRUMENTAL OF THE YEAR at the **Australian Country Music Awards (The Golden Guitars)** with their powerhouse instrumental **OMFG**. They were also finalists in the **Group/Duo** category with their original song **WRITE ME A LETTER**.

The **Davidson Brothers** also won the **BLUEGRASS and the INSTRUMENTAL awards** at the 2012 Victorian Country Music Awards in February, held in South Morang, Victoria.

While taking a trip farther afield, **Hamish and Lachlan** visited Nashville to record a new album '**Here To Stay**'. The album will only be available from their website, so give them a hand and spread the word! Postage is FREE to anywhere in the world!

**Hamish and Lachlan** grew up in the rural Victorian town of **Yinnar**. Raised in a musical family, the brothers began playing music and performing from a young age.

With seven albums under their belt, they have built the reputation of being one of **Australia's hottest bluegrass acts** – multi instrumentalists on banjo, fiddle and mandolin, and great entertainers with an enormous respect for the traditions of the blue grass genre.

**Australian Country Music Award winners in 2009, 2010 and 2012, and Group of the Year** at the **2010 Australian Independent Country Music Awards**, **Hamish and Lachlan Davidson** are "the best young bluegrass pickers we have seen for a long while in Australia and according to **Troy Cassar-Daley** "A very exciting live act."

Their latest album, **Here To Stay** contains eleven new tracks, ten of which are written by the brothers. It features many of **Hamish and Lachlan's** favourite Nashville session musicians playing with them on a wide range of tracks – from a 180 beat per minute banjo instrumental to more classic stories of **heartbreak and Australian culture**.

Whilst **Here To Stay** remains steeped in bluegrass tradition, it contains a dash of new grass flavours and the **Davidson Brothers' live energy**.

The brothers have toured with Australian country music veterans such as **Troy Cassar-Daley** and **Lee Kernaghan**, shared the stage with household names like **Tommy Emmanuel, Kasey Chambers and Jimmy Barnes** and have also performed on many national television programs including **Spicks & Specks** and **Good Morning Australia**.
