## Ma's Country Kitchen

### Apple Cinnamon Slice



1 med Apple  
 ½ tbs Brown sugar  
 ½ tsp Cinnamon  
 1tbl Water  
 1 Sheet Filo Pastry  
 Melted Butter  
 Ice Cream or Custard to served

#### Method

Pre- heat oven to 200c or 190 c for fan force and line baking tray.

Peel and core apple. Cut into slices. Place apple, sugar, cinnamon and water into a saucepan over medium heat. Cook, stirring occasionally until apple is tender.

Remove from heat. Strain apples and reserve the liquid.

Place sheet of pastry on work surface, working quickly, brush one half sparingly with melted butter.

Fold other half over, spoon desired amount of apple onto centre of pastry. Fold the edges over, making a pillow.

Place on baking tray, Brush with melted butter. Repeat with each piece of pastry.

Bake for 10- 15mins or until golden brown.

Serve immediately with custard or ice cream and drizzle reserved liquid over the top.

This recipe is for one person, but if you need more just double or triple as you wish.

'Open House' on Sunday 29th, from 11am to 4.00pm, will feature Lindsay Butler, Shaza Leigh, well known artists from Tamworth, Melody Feder from Adelaide, and Heartland, a well known band from Adelaide.

The Country Breakfast at Laura Caravan Park and the Workshop with Lindsay and Shaza at the RSL Memorial Hall on Sunday morning will complete the great program of Country Music.
