## A Tribute to Bill Northcott The Road Home



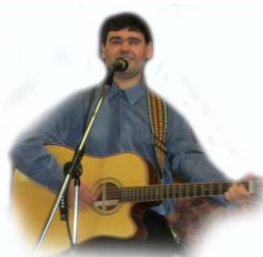
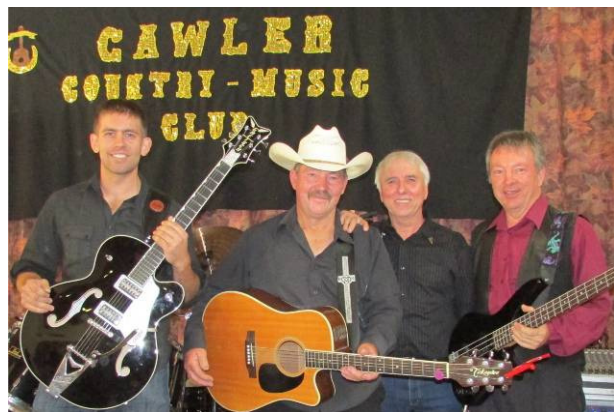
*I have come to the end of the road

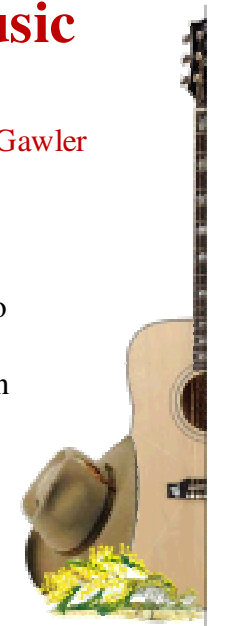
