RM Williams Venture

The owner of iconic Australian retailer **RM Williams** has sold a portion of the boot making and clothing business to help fuel its expansion. The owner Ken Cowley was seeking offers of about \$100 million for the 81 year old company.

However a recent linkup between **RM Williams** and Singapore-based **L Capital Asia**, has taken place. An odd liaison: **a little bit country, a little bit city**.

Financial experts have welcomed the more than \$50 million tie-up between the two.

Mr Cowley assumed full control over the bush outfitter following the death of its founder, **Reginald Murray (RM) Williams** in 2003.

RM Williams exports to 15 countries and has more than 50 retail stores and 900 stockists. It generates annual sales of about \$100 million and has flagship stores in London and New York. Plans are in place to open stores, first in Singapore, Hong Kong and eventually Europe.

It has recently been reported that a movie on the life of **RM Williams** is in the pipe-line. Could be a boot scoot'n block buster!
