The **Alcheringa Hall Of Fame** in **Wellington, South Australia** is featured regularly in **Country Music** news.

In true **Country** fashion this isolated landmark is snuggled in amongst rolling hills and rocky outcrops. This golden nugget of Australian history, the brainchild of **Dave Williams**, has become a true blue Aussie tourist attraction.

Dave, a perfect gentleman, and nephew of the legendary **R.M. Williams**, is a regular visitor to our **Gawler Country Music Club**.

You may have seen his **Country Music** handicrafts featuring decorative clocks and wall-hangings etc. They are often on display at our club on special occasions such as our annual **Slim Dusty Tribute Show**.

When one visits **Dave's Place** in **Alcheringa** his love of horses and Australian memorabilia becomes obvious. Dave's museum captures the many subtle elements of the Australian way of life, its music and its people.

David Williams is known for his training and the showing of his beautiful **Andalusian Spanish Dancing Horses**.

He has bred many champions; won considerable recognition, broken many records and worked alongside most of our great **Country Music** artists.

Dave owned and trained **Australia's first Line Dancing Horse 'Domero'**, and three more of **Dave's** magnificent horses were chosen to feature in the block buster movie, **'Lord Of The Rings.'**

The producers of the movie were so impressed by the performances of the four horses that they gave **Dave** a priceless collection of **Lord Of The Rings** artifacts which are now proudly on display.

Country Music relics collected over the past fifty years can be viewed at the small but packed museum at **Dave's Place', Alcheringa**.

If you are looking for a day trip by car or coach, you will find it on the **Murray Bridge to Wellington road**, between **Jervois** and **Wellington** on the **South** side of the **Murray River**.

You will also see regular advertising features in our newsletter of many of **Dave's Country Music events** held at his place, with profits mainly going to the **Royal Flying Doctor's Service**.
