Warrior in Chains!

Roger Knox is often referred to, in the Aboriginal community, as the black Elvis.

He is a Gamilaroi man who was born at Moree, northwest NSW and grew up at Toomelah mission near Boggabilla on the NSW QLD border.



Roger started his musical career as a gospel singer and in the early 1980's defied the odds surviving not one but two plane crashes, suffering burns to most of his body.

With his band, **Euraba** he has dedicated his life to sharing the gift of music with the world, spending much of his time playing to neglected Aboriginal audiences in remote communities and prisons, as well as touring detention centres and Indian reservations in the US and Canada.
