Tandoori Cutlets

Contents:

12 Lamb Cutlets
2 Tablespoons bottled Tandoori Paste
¼ cup of plain Yogurt
1 tablespoon chopped fresh Coriander
1 clove Garlic crushed
Cooked Rice and Pappadums to serve

Trim excess fat from cutlets.

Using a meat mallet, gently pound cutlets until slightly flattened.

Combine tandoori paste, yoghurt coriander and garlic in a bowl.

Brush both sides of cutlets with tandoori mixture.

Place cutlets in a single layer on a rack over a baking dish.

Cook in a moderate oven, 180c, for 30 mins or until cooked as desired.

Serve cutlets with cooked rice and pappadums, garnish with fresh herbs.

Lemon Angel Pie

Ingredients:

6 egg yolks
2/3 cup sugar
1/2 cup freshly squeezed lemon juice (approx 3 lemons)
2 tablespoons of grated lemon rind
1 cup of fresh whipped cream
Grated nutmeg if you like

Beat yolks until thick and lemon colored

Gradually beat in the sugar

Blend in lemon juice and rind

Cook over a saucepan of medium heat water until thick, (approx 10 mins) stirring constantly.

Cool slightly, then spoon into your Pavlova Shell. Sprinkle with Nutmeg.

Medium sized Pavlova.

Double recipe for large one.

Letter from a Tasmanian Mother to her son

Dear Son

I'm writing this letter slow because I know you can't read fast.

We don't live where we did when you left home. Your dad read in the newspaper that most accidents happen within 20kms of your home, so we moved. I won't be able to send you the address because the last Tasmanian family that live here took the house numbers when they moved so that they wouldn't have to change their address.

This place is really nice. It even has a washing machine. I'm not sure it works so well though: last week I put a load in and pulled the chain and haven't seen them since.

The weather isn't bad here. It only rained twice last week, the first time for three days and second... for four days.

About that coat you wanted me to send you. Your Uncle Stanley said it would be too heavy to send in the mail with the buttons on, so we cut them off and put them in your pockets.

John locked his keys in the car yesterday. We were really worried because it took him two hours to get me and your father out.

Your sister had a baby this morning, but I haven't found out what it is yet so I don't know if you're an uncle or aunty. The baby looks just like your brother ...

Uncle Ted fell in a whiskey vat last week. Some men tried to pull him out but he fought them off playfully and drowned. We had him cremated and he burned for three days.

Three of your friends went off a bridge in a Ute. Ralph was driving; he rolled down the window and swam to safety. Your other two friends were in the back. They drowned because they couldn't get the tailgate down.

There isn't much more news at this time. Nothing much has happened.
