As part of her journey toward the **Telstra Road to Tamworth Final in Tamworth** next January, **Kristal** will progress to the next stage of the competition - which includes a performance at one of Sydney's biggest sporting events - the Sydney Telstra 500 V8 Supercar event held at Homebush in December.

"**Boot Camp**" is a music development workshop where contestants will gain valuable experience and advice from leading music industry professionals, as well as the opportunity to rehearse with a full band.

As part of the camp, **Kristal** will perform in front of V8 Supercar fans together with **The McClymonts and previous TRTT winners.**

**Kristal** qualified for "Boot Camp" after impressing the judges at The Royal Adelaide Show last Saturday.

Winning the Adelaide heat title has topped off a very successful year for **Kristal**, who graduated from the **CMAA College of Country Music** in January and won the **Trans Tasman Entertainer of the Year Award** at the **Norfolk Island Country Music Festival** in May (the first ever South Australian to win the award).

Aspiring songwriters also have until 1 November to enter the **Telstra Road to Tamworth songwriter category** for their chance to win a trip to **Nashville.**
