JohnO and his authentic country songs had true blue Country Music fans in the audience listening intently. I'm sorry to say John's songs were difficult to hear above the considerably loud talking in some sections of the audience. A shame, 'cos John's songs are real Aussie Country Songs from his real farming background.

Singer-songwriter **John O'Dea** is a man of passion. Writing songs and watching the effect they have on people is almost an addiction for this former wheat farmer from the South Australian **Flinders Ranges.**

Having played and sung music all his life, in bands and as a soloist, it was only in the past five years that he began to think he could make a career from his lifelong passion.
