
had on his children when one sees the smile on his face as he sticks his hand into

He has experienced success performing in Australia and overseas; and played on the albums of some of Australia's most notable country artists including Adam Harvey, Cat Southern, Paul Costa, Corinna Cordwell, Barry Thornton, Lindsay Butler and Reg Poole.

In addition to his role as Musical Director and Lead Guitarist of the extremely popular and successful Adelaide based family band, "The Sherrahs", Anthony has worked live on stage with some of Australia's top acts, including Karen O'Shea, Michael King, Owen Blundell, Brian Letton and Craig Giles.

His family band "The Sherrahs" gained much notoriety on the nationwide circuit when they released 'Keep in the Light' on ABC Country, followed by 'Reason and Rhyme' recorded at Red Brick Music Studio.

It was Anthony's love for Country Music that resulted in the launch of the Red Brick Music Recording Studio, and he is now in constant demand providing professional recording services and advice to many prominent artists.

These days **Anthony** shares his time between his **Family**, **Red Brick Music** and **Live Performances**.
