Chocolate Cake

If you like **Country** you like **Chocolate!**

2 cups Self-raising Flour

4 tablespoons Cocoa

½ cup Sugar

2 tablespoons Golden Syrup

1 teaspoon Bicarbonate of soda

1 ½ cups hot Water

4 ½ tablespoons Butter, softened

1 teaspoon Vanilla Essence

Frosting

3 tablespoon Chocolate Squares

3 tablespoons Margarine or Butter

1 ½ cups Icing Sugar Mixture

2 tablespoon s Cocoa

3 tablespoons Milk

1 teaspoon Vanilla Essence

Turn on oven to 160c and grease two 20cm sandwich tins.

Sift flour and cocoa in a bowl, and then add sugar.

In a small bowl combine golden syrup and hot water, stir in bicarbonate soda and stir until dissolved. Add butter and vanilla essence stir until butter melts. Pour into mixing bowl and mix everything together.

Pour mixture into two sandwich tins, dividing mixture as evenly as possible between the tins. Bake for 20 minutes, cool for 5 minutes, then turn upside down on a wire rack.

Frosting

Heat chocolate squares and butter in a saucepan, stirring, sift in cocoa and icing sugar. Add milk and vanilla essence. Beat icing until thick and forms peaks. Spread over cake.
