Anyone interested in participating in group bookings for shows such as the Charlie Pride Concert, please contact me and I will apply for discount tickets.

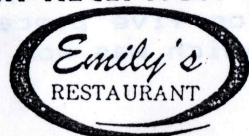

FESTIVAL UPDATE:

The annual Gawler Country Music Festival is now just six months away and the Gawler club will be organising the festival this year, together with the Gawler Tourist Association and the Country Music Federation. Regular meetings are being held and implementing plans to make this year's festival much bigger and better.

National stars booked to appear (subject to change) include:- Reg Lindsay; Chad Morgan; The Howie Brothers; Lionel Rose; Olive Bice; plus many local artists such as Johnny Mac, Carole Sturtzel, Rocky page, Kahren. Our President, Glen Harrison, is busy negotiating with many more artists.

We plan on having a lot more entertainment on the Monday Holiday (October 4th) and also buskers and entertainment, in the main street for the whole week.

Different functions are planned for every night from October 5th to 8th and, on the 9th there is the prestigious presentation of awards and concert. I will give you more details later. The street parade will be much bigger this year. Plans to include Clydsdales, Pipe and Brass bands, Marching Girls, Pony Clubs etc, are well underway. If you know of anyone who is interested in being a part of the parade please have them contact me as soon as possible.

Due to the big response last year for seating at the Saturday night concert, reserved "numbered seats" will go on sale this year from August 1st. Unlike last year all seating will be numbered and sold correspondingly. Keep in mind that last year's concert was a sellout, so! - get in early.

An integral part of the festival is the induction of prominent pioneering artists into the Gallery of Country Music Stars. This year there will be five more added to the gallery.

The Gallery of Country Music Stars will be displayed in the new Gawler Tourist Office.
