

Enclosed is a leaflet on Harris's Coach Tour. This was booked out last year, and some seats are already booked for 1996, so get in early and don't miss out. Tamworth Festival is hard to describe to someone who has never seen it, but I have never yet heard anyone say they were dissappointed.

There is lots happening on the Country Music scene. A major step forward for our industry is the introduction of a T.A.F.E. training course in Country Music. The curriculum will include advanced stagecraft, business skills, management, recording skills and techniques and some level of technical skills to enable trainees to deal with performing before large audiences in large venues.

The first seven day residential course should begin in Tamworth later this year.

The South Australian Council for Country Music is planning to attempt to have something similar here in South Australia.

Yodelling is still alive and well. Angela Hayden has a new album out called "GIVE 'EM ANOTHER ENCORE" and Mary Schneider has recently released an album "MARY SCHNEIDER YODELLS THE CLASSICS". This has to be heard to be believed. Johnny Chester has released a C.D. "SONGMAKER" which includes a duet with FREDDY FENDER".



Our own Country Music Festival is coming together in leaps and bounds. This year there will be much more happening at the Racecourse on Sunday 19th November. Along with JOHN WILLIAMSON's show, there will be multi events happening all over the racecourse.




