

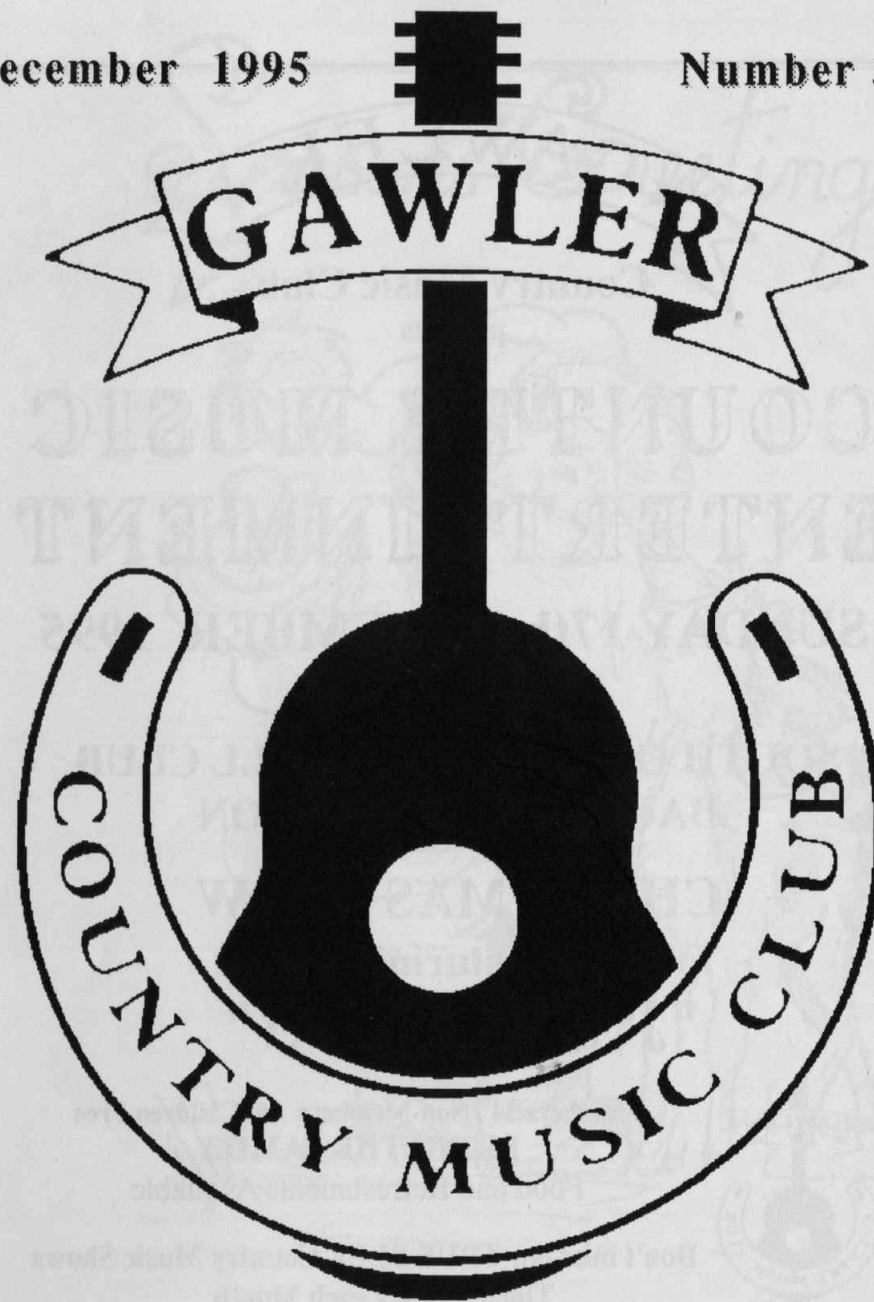

PETER COAD AND THE COAD SISTERS Virginia and Lynette, have entertained at the Sydney Opera House, The Gympie Muster, The Royal Adelaide Show, appeared with... legendary Tom T Hall, Brisbane Expo 88, festivals and clubs through out Australia.

Originally from Hawker in SA they now reside in the Southern Highlands in Bundanoon NSW.

"We've been involved in the entertainment industry for well over ten years now" Peter said "I worked with my brother Trevor as the COAD BROTHERS in the early eighties, we made three albums together which I still sell at shows. As a solo I released an album in 88 'Peter Coad Vol 1', but my most successful has been the latest 'RAINBOW ROAD' which has received great airplay and industry support. I had two of my songs become finalists in the Tamworth Songwriters Awards in 94,

'If only I was young' and 'I just wish I'd thought of that', at present I am compiling original material for a new album."

Virginia and Lynette (the COAD SISTERS) have also had Extensive airplay with their song 'Wild weird and wonderful' from their album 'Times in your life' from last year.

"We're just putting the finishing touches to our new album, all original material. The audience response to the material has been great and we feel we've captured the 'happening vibe' live in the studio so we can't wait to get it out in the record shops and on radio".

"Yes, we mix in new material with the other that we do so our format is always exciting and different".
