



MONTE CARLO dance was won by DOT BURKE & DANNY ROWETT who won the wine and chocolates but also failed to draw the Jackpot.


MEMBERS DOOR PRIZE, a lovely barrel of chicken donated by KFC GAWLER, was won by BILL NORTHCOTE.
