



With the applause not yet faded on his 1995 award wins for his album *Homeland*, Connors is almost daring his supporters to *move on*, with the mid year release of his latest album......

"As the title suggests, Homeland was then, this album is where I am, musically, here and now", says Connors.

Seven new songs, all written in the last 6 months are blended expertly by Connors with three further tracks: The Ringer and The Princess selected from his live performance repertoire, and a classic example of Connors' story telling ability; Sun Arise, a song written by Rolf Harris and Harry Butler which Connors has masterfully reworked with powerful rhythms and exceptional vocal efforts; and an anthemic rendition - complete with orchestra and choir - of his 1988 Bicentennial song, written for Slim Dusty, We've Done Us Proud.

Connors lets the listener know from track one, Welcome to the Here and Now that they're in for a no holds barred musical experience. It also unmasks Connors' growth as a music producer, from its fast and furious fiddle and banjo licks, strong guitar and driving rhythm to the subtleties of Fireflies, all complemented by his unmistakeable lyric wizardry.
