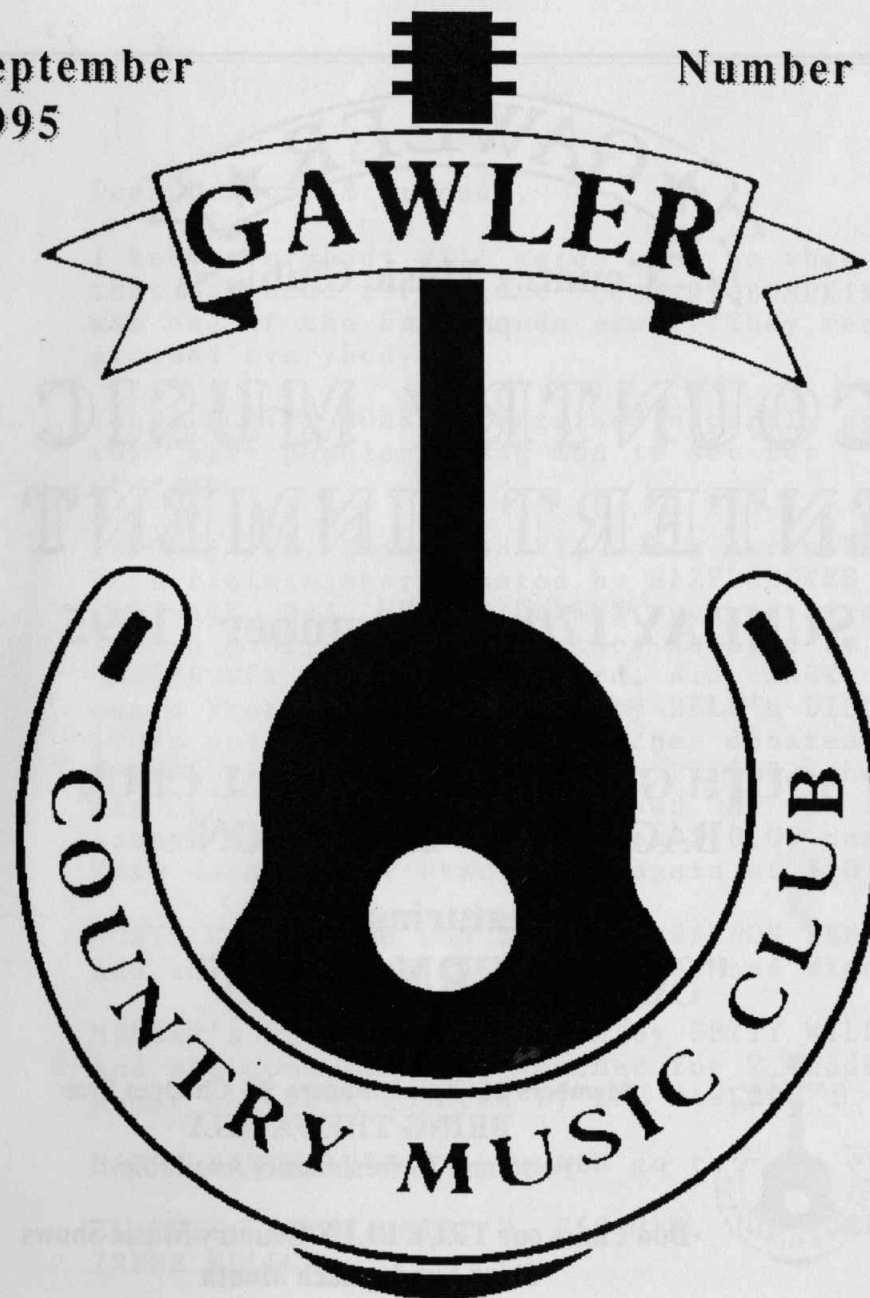

after our Festival.

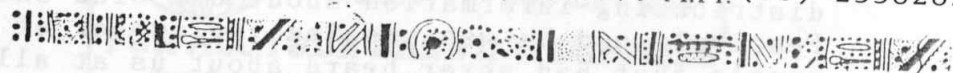

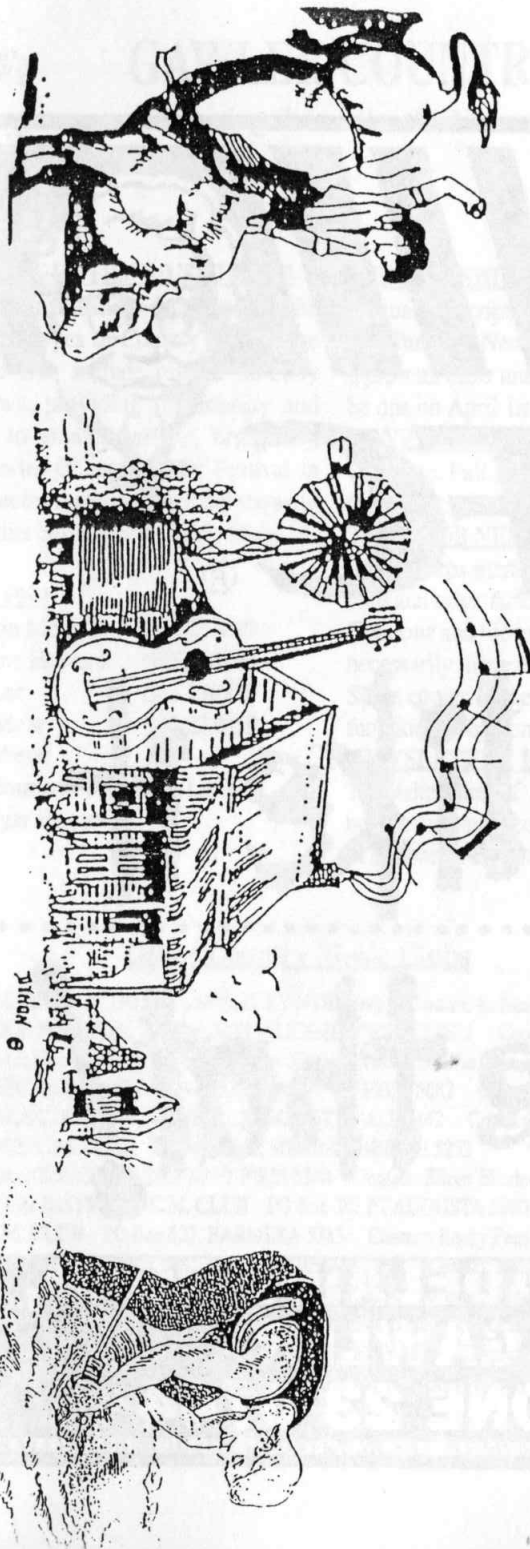
