



RECIPES BY GORDON BLUE

I have been told by many of our members that since including recipes in our monthly newsletter their eating habits have changed - for the better I hope. So with this in mind, I have decided to give you the recipe inspired by Saint Pudding of Yorkshire.

Hence the Yorkshire Pudding.

History books will tell you that before sailing from England, Captain Cook asked his missus to cook up a few ton of the pudding for him to take with him on his trip to find Australia. It would help to feed the crew, and if he arrived on a weekend he may get invited to a BBQ, and he would have something to put on the table. He also found that if the ship "sprang a leak" a piece of pudding nailed over the hole kept it watertight!

INGREDIENTS

150g Flour, 1 large egg, 300ml milk, beef dripping and a pinch of salt.

Sift flour and salt into a bowl. Make a well in the centre. Tip egg (minus shell) and a little milk in and beat well, gradually incorporating the flour and adding more of the milk as necessary until you have a smooth batter.

Allow to stand for 30 minutes.

Place a tablespoon of beef dripping into a roasting tin. Set gas oven at Mark 7 (220 deg), place tin in the top of oven for 5 minutes until the fat is smoking (Check fire brigade phone number). Working quickly, remove the tin, pour in batter and return to the oven until PUFFY and golden brown. A large tin takes about 40 - 45 minutes.

This pudding is also the reason for the Yorkshire Accent, because it can stick to the roof of your mouth.

If asked "Are you from Yorkshire?" you reply "No, I have a piece of pudding stuck to the roof of my mouth" - with a Yorkshire Accent of course.
