




RECIPES BY GORDON BLUE

This month it's an International recipe for you all to try. It's from Wales - that is the Welsh one not the New South one.

This is the time of year when the native Welsh people go hunting for the elusive Rarebit. (rare bit of what Terry?)!!!

Armed with a leek and bucket with a lid on and led by Welsh male voice choir, they move through the mountains hoping to scare out of their burrows the Rarebit. Hearing the choir the little creature comes out of it's hole to see what all the noise is about, and the hunter stuns it with a thump with the leek, then puts it into the bucket and closes the lid quickly because they can move pretty fast. The hunters return to their cottages to prepare for a feast of Rarebit.

We now have an Authentic Welsh Rarebit recipe.

INGREDIENTS

1/2lb cheese 4 slices of toast teaspoon butter salt & pepper

2 teaspoons worcesteshire sauce 1 teaspoon dry mustard 2 teaspoons flour 4 tablespoons milk or beer

Toast the bread - grate the cheese into a saucepan and heat gently until it melts. Add other ingredients and mix well. Spread over toast and grill until brown. Serves 4.

From around the villages you may often hear that wonderful Welsh shout of LLANFAIRPWLLGWYNGYLLGOGERYCHWYRNDROBWLLLLANTYSY LIOGOGOGOCH which roughly translated means 'Strewth, I've burnt my tongue on the hot cheese."

A bottle of wine for any member who can pronounce the word & two bottles if you know what it means.


