RECIPES BY GORDON BLUE

One is for an Apple Cake and the other is "How to get oil off your concrete drive."

The member who gave me the Apple Cake recipe doesn't want to be named and I understand this as she is a very shy - quiet person - so here it is.

THE MARION APPLE CAKE

2oz Butter

Topping

1/2 cup Castor sugar

1/2 cup sugar

1 1/2 cup S.R. Flour

2 Tspoons Cinnamon

1-2 Apples

1 Tspoon Butter

1 Egg

1/2 cup Milk

Method.

Beat butter and sugar til creamy, add egg - then add flour and milk alternately. Peel and slice apples, place on top of cake. Sprinkle on the topping. Bake in a moderate oven for 45mins.
