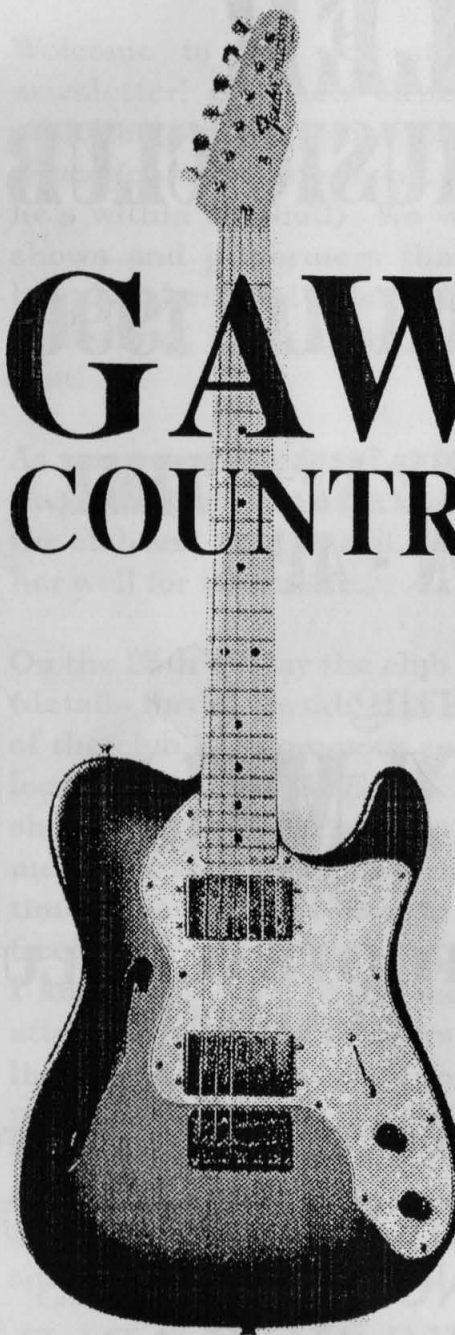

Here is No: 1.

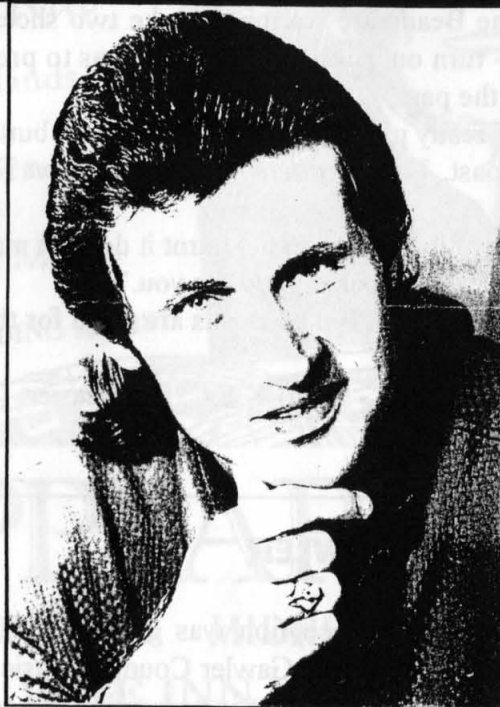

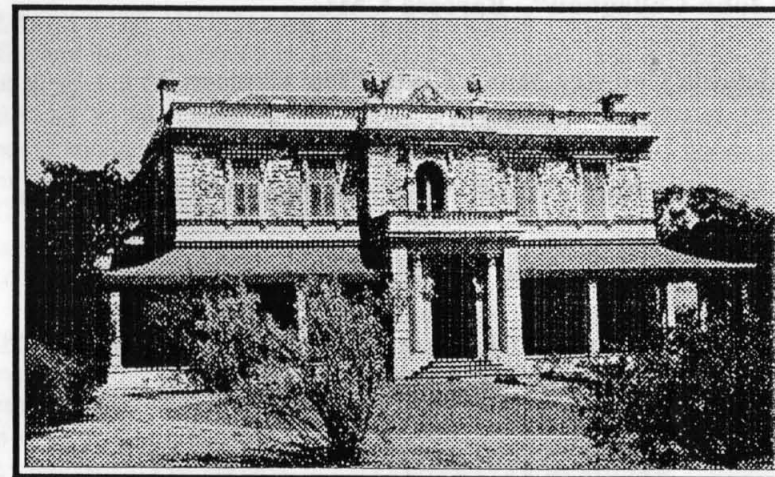

Para Para Mansion



Walter Duffield, a flour miller, bought the land known as Para Para, west of present day Gawler, in 1851. The mansion was completed in 1862 and reflected Duffield's position as one of Gawler's most prominent citizens, with business interests including milling, sheep runs and vineyards.

The name Para Para signifies the junction of the North and South Para rivers which are amongst the most prominent natural features of the Gawler region.
