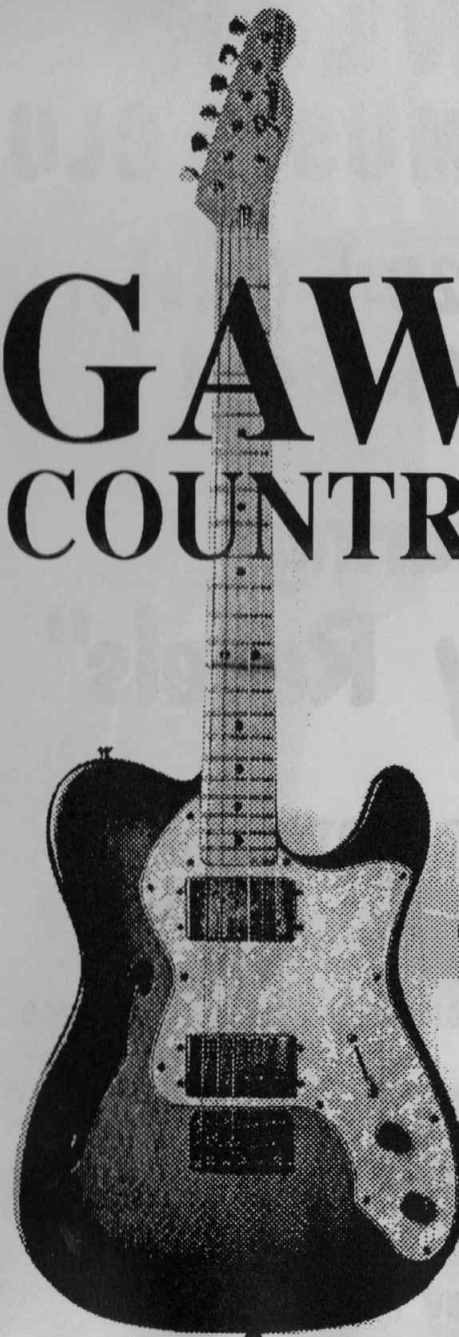

RECIPES by GORDON BLUE

Thank you for those get well cards and those who didn't send one. - I know who you are !!!

This month a simple recipe, this is one that the less fortunate in our society often used to make like politicians - solicitors - bank managers - bricklayers and come to think of "Definitely Bricklayers"

This is called Bread Pudding - made with any left over bread you would usually feed to the chooks.

1kg stale bread	250g shredded suet
500g brown sugar	500g mixed dried fruits
3 eggs	2 teaspoons mixed spices
50g butter	

Soak the bread in water for a while for at least 30 minutes.

Drain and squeeze out excess moisture.

Mash with a fork and add the remaining ingredients except the butter.

Mix well together and spread into a greased baking tin. Dot with butter and bake in the oven, 350°F (180°C) for about 2 hours until nicely browned. You will find it's quite heavy
