



1995 saw her chosen as best Female Vocalist and overall Runner-up at the TRANS-TASMAN ENTERTAINER OF THE YEAR AWARDS on Norfolk Island, followed by a Grand Final spot at Tamworth in the prestigious STAR MAKER QUEST. Tanya also released her first recording, reaching the top 10 on the Country Charts.

In March this year Tanya was voted BEST NEW TALENT at the VICTORIAN COUNTRY MUSIC AWARDS, and was a finalist in the Best Female Vocalist Award.

Tanya has an album release planned for the end of this year, and no doubt will preview some of her new songs at Gawler. She is looking forward to appearing here in November and is sure to make a great impression.


