Doug McIntyre's third album is *"Riding Free"*. All ten tracks were created by the Southern Highlands singer-songwriter's own pen with production credits to the current CMAA Producer Of The Year Matt Fell (Sara Storer, John Williamson, Graeme Connors).

"Back In The Little Town" - the album's first single that went to radio last month is the captivating story of the Australian prodigal son. The son leaves home, blows his inheritance in Brisbane, ends up sleeping in a cardboard box under the city's 'Story Bridge', then crawls back home where the 'old man' accepts him with open arms.

Taylor Swift's Red Tour has become the biggest revenue earner for a country act.

The 15-month world trek grossed over \$US150 million (\$A162.29 million) and surpasses Tim McGraw and Faith Hill's Soul2Soul tour in 2006 and 2007, according to Billboard.

The Red tour began in March 2013 and took in Australia, Europe and Asia before ending in Singapore on June 12 this year.

In total, over 1.7 million fans caught Swift onstage during her 86 performances in 12 countries.

The seven-time Grammy Award winner became the only female solo artist in twenty years to undertake a national stadium concert tour of Australia when she kicked-off the Australian leg of her Red tour at Sydney's Allianz Stadium on December 4.

Earlier this year, Swift was named Billboard's Top Money Maker for the second time.

The singer beat out Kenny Chesney, Justin Timberlake and The Rolling Stones for the number one spot thanks to profits from her Red album and tour.
