


<u>Australia's preparing for its next COVID-19 wave — here's a</u> look at the rules if you test positive

As per Australia's preparing for its next COVID-19 wave — here's a look at the rules if you test positive - ABC News 8/11/2022

South Australia

<u>SA</u> Health encourages anyone with COVID-19 symptoms to get tested and stay at home until symptoms have cleared, which, it says, usually takes five to seven days.

If you are COVID-19 positive and you <u>must</u> leave the house, SA Health strongly recommends you wear a mask, especially when indoors or on public transport, and that you do not attend large gatherings and crowded indoor places.

For at least seven days, you should avoid people at high risk of severe illness, or anyone in a hospital, aged or disability care facility.

You must report a positive RAT result online with SA Health.




