September Southern Skys was the entertainment for that month.


October Key Country made an appearance to entertain everyone.

Spotlight on Life Members Ian Fisk

Photographer Extraordinaire, and Webmaster



lan Fisk, who everyone who attends our club shows knows, is the photographer who captures all our winners and grinners, our current band and random shots of the days events.

lan is also the Web Master who looks after our club web page. Ian does so very much more than just our club, this guy is EVERYWHERE that country music is happening.

lan was born in Montreal, Quebec Canada, he and his family moved to (*in his own words*) "God's Country, Beautiful British Columbia" when very young.

His early years included taking piano lessons, both classical and popular. Ian said that he tried playing Country music from books and sheet

music for years, music was definitely in his blood.

Moving into adulthood, Ian spent 19 months in the Canadian Artic as a Radio Operator. In 1969 he planned a trip around the Pacific, but somehow couldn't make it past Australia. Instead of continuing with his trip, he began to settle down with the love of his life Pam, (the reason he didn't make it past Australia). Now 55 years later, Ian and Pam are still very much married and committed to each other.

lan's Father was born in Sydney and this meant that lan had no difficulty in getting permanent residence and citizenship.

The first Country Music Club Ian went to was the Adelaide Country Music Club (ACMC) when they met at the Function Centre of the SA Greyhound Racing Authority at Angle Park. Later he started going to the Southern Country Music Club as well. Living in South Brighton he didn't attend many Gawler Country Music Club meetings, but did go to some, mainly the Slim Dusty ones.

lan listened to Wally Sparrow's country music program on Saturday morning's Radio Adelaide for years. When he announced back in 2002 that the SA Council for Country Music (SACCM) was looking for someone to be their webmaster, he volunteered to do the job.

From SACCM, to Country Music SA to his own website which he started in 2015, Ian has kept busy updating various websites with artists profiles, and a gig guide since then. He also read out the Gig Guide for Wally Sparrow's show after complaining to Wally about the way he was reading it.

lan was on the SACCM and Country Music SA committees for years, after taking over the Publicity Officer position the ACMC, he joined the committee in 2006. and to this day still produces their newsletter, Country Call flyers, their website (acmc.org.au) and their Facebook page.

lan took the Playford Country Music Club (PCMC) Webmaster position in late 2017 and has been doing so eversince. He also joined the committee at that time and produces the flyers for all our shows.

When it comes to photography, Ian says he has been taking pictures since he was knee high to a grasshopper! (a long time). He started with black and white film and later many colour slides especially on trips. He went digital in 1998. His photos went into many SACCM Prelude and Country Music SA publications over many years, and also in the ACMC Country Call as well as the PCMC newsletters. Many of the artists he's photographed over the years also use his photos.

Attending many Country Music, Bluegrass and folk festivals and club meetings for years, taking what must be a huge collection of photo's, which can be found on his website http://ww.ianfisk.au/

I wasn't as stressed this time. Things just run a lot smoother when we are all there. Plus, my boys are also our comic relief. They have me laughing from the moment they arrive. They are a bit chaotic but they are certainly entertaining.

Not much else to report this month so I will include a recipe for Peanut butter biscuits.

PEANUT BUTTER BISCUITS

I've discovered in life that you either love peanut butter, or you hate it. These are a delicious easy to make biscuit that will have you wanting more.

- 1 cup butter or margarine
- 1 cup crunchy peanut butter
- 1 cut white sugar
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 2 eggs
- 2½ cups S. R. Flour



Preheat oven to 160°c and Line 4 oven trays with baking paper. There is no need to grease them.

- 1. Beat the butter and both sugars in a large bowl with an electric mixer until smooth. Add the eggs and continue to mix.
- 2. Add in the flour and mix until just combined. Place in refrigerator for 30 minutes.
- 3. Roll spoonful's of mixture into balls and place on tray approx. 5cm apart. I get 12 to each tray.
- 4. Dip a fork into icing sugar (*this stops the fork sticking to the dough*) press the fork into the dough to flatten. Make a criss-cross patterns.
- 5. Place in the oven for about 10 minutes or until the edges are starting to brown.
- 6. Remove from the oven and cool completely on the tray.
