Our thoughts go out to her family and friends. Rest in peace Natalie.



# FIONA'S TUCKERBOX

## MAY SHOW.

G'day friends, there isn't much to report this month. Thank you for returning your plates to the kitchen early. We really appreciate the effort. It makes our clean up so much more efficient. With less people through the door today we had a bit of food left over. Don't forget we will always have take-away meals available if there is any food left over. Here is a winter warmer recipe.

### CURRIED SAUSAGES

6 to 8 Beef sausages	1 tablespoon Keens curry powder
2 onions sliced	2 cups beef stock
1 large carrot thinly sliced	1 tablespoon margarine
1 cup peas	¼ cup Worcestershire sauce
2 cups mushrooms	3 Tablespoons plain flour
1 teaspoon minced garlic	



Cook the sausages in a fry pan and put to the side once cooked. In a medium bowl mix the curry powder, plain flour and stock together, set aside.

While the sausages are cooking add the margarine to a large saucepan or pot. Cook the onion and garlic together. Once the onions are tender add the carrots and fry until just tender too. Cook like this for 2 minutes and then add the stock mixture a little at a time. Mixing in between each addition. Now Add the mushroom and peas and Worcestershire sauce then bring to the boil.

Cut the sausages into bite sized pieces and add to the curry mixture. Cook for a further 10 minutes. The liquid should thicken nicely. Serve with mashed potatoes or rice and a good crusty bread.

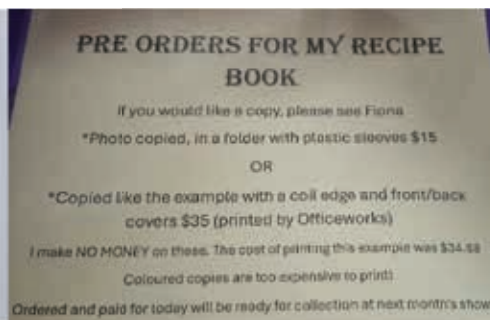
## JUNE SHOW.

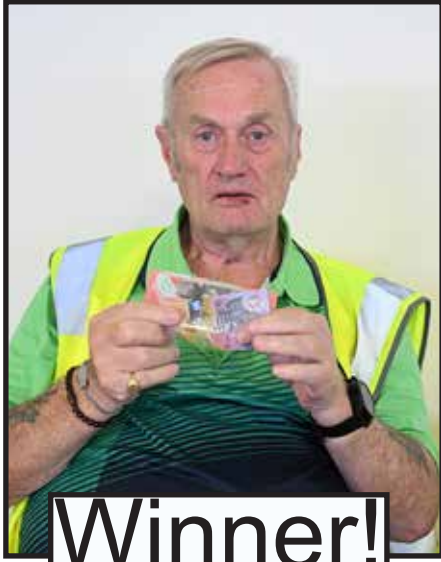

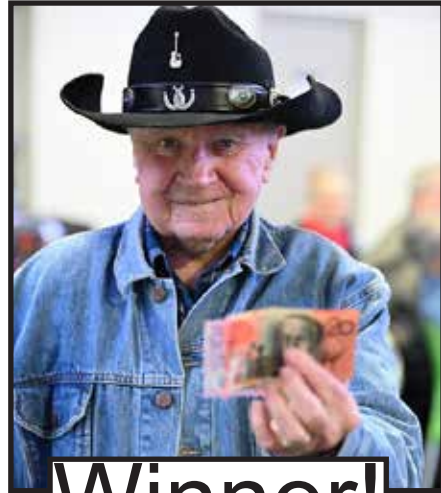

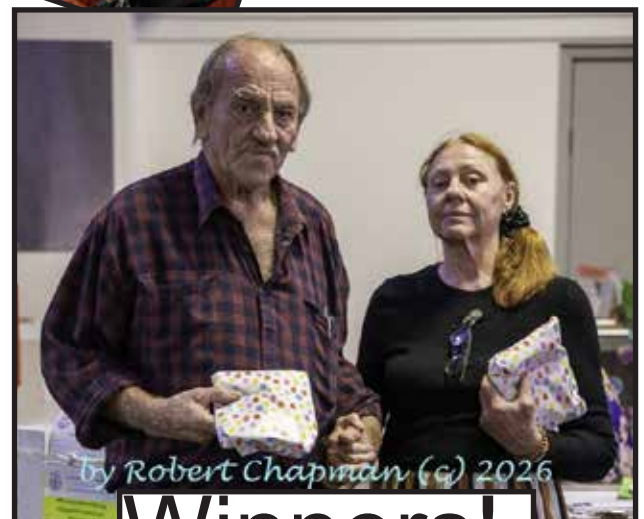
